

The registration of candidates for the Cambridge International Examinations (Checkpoint, IGCSE, AS/A Level) is already in progress. The deadline for the registration is 20 January 2020.

We thank the parents who have already paid the examination fees and we encourage those who have not yet paid to do so before the deadline.

The Parents whose children are being registered for Cambridge Examinations for the first time will receive declaration forms to confirm the spelling, order of names and date of birth before registration.

PLAYTRYENJOY LEARN & WIN TOGETHER



The International Fun Science Olympiad (IFSO) is a Science (Biology, Chemistry and Physics) as well as Mathematics competition which will be held in Frankfurt, Germany from 27 April to 2 May 2020, and thereafter participants will go for a trip to Paris, France from 2 to 4 May 2020. The main aim is to increase the motivation and interest of the participants in Sciences and Mathematics by enabling learners of all abilities to understand the applications of STEM in daily life and also increase their self-confidence, as they compete with their peers from all over the world.

The competition involves two categories; Junior (Year 7, 8 and 9) and Senior (Year 10, 11 and 12)
